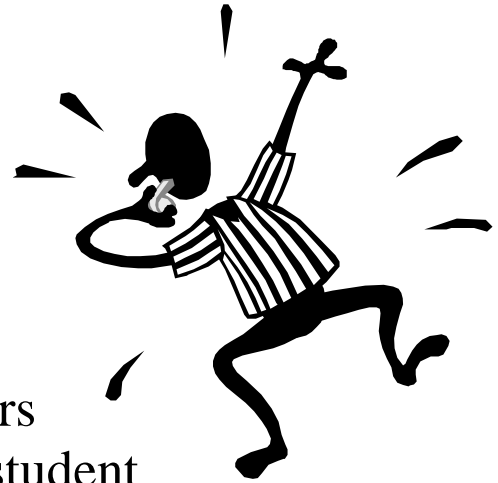


Are there times when you feel like a referee in the classroom?



Do you wish campus administrators were trained to better understand student discipline?

Senator Mario Gallegos agrees with you and has introduced SB 345.

SB 345 calls for the following:

***Staff Development Training For Administrators
Regarding Discipline Management***

“(a) Each principal or other appropriate administrator who oversees student discipline shall, at least once every third school year, attend staff development training regarding discipline management under this subchapter, including training that provides information relating to the distinction between a discipline management technique used at the principal’s discretion under Section 37.002(a) and the discretionary authority of a teacher to remove a disruptive student under Section 37.002(b).”

This training will allow administrators to better understand your rights to remove disruptive students who continually interfere with the ability of other students to learn. If you agree with this idea, you can take action by doing the following.
