Testing reform

Texas AFT members made progress in the fight to return testing to its proper place – an instructional guide for professional educators – when the Legislature began a top-to-bottom review of testing excesses and agreed to switch to move to end-of-course exams.

But testing remains out of control and some lawmakers remain intent on tying test scores to pay and other unproven ideas.

School finance

The Legislature has failed to deliver on promised state aid but keeps piling on more and more mandates. In 2006, the Lege took it further and handcuffed schools' ability to raise additional local funding to pay for the basics such as inflation and salaries. Since the change, more than 200 school districts have been tied up in expensive and time-consuming campaigns to win confusing tax-rate elections.
